You MUST NOT drive a car, motorcycle, scooter, or any motor vehicle requiring a license while you are in Indonesia, regardless of that you may have a license at home.2. You MUST NOT hitchhike, not even in company.3. All students are FORBIDDEN to use drug not prescribed for medical purpose, and other illegal substances. |

BINA ANTARBUDAYA REGULATION

1. Students are obliged to attend school in full to meet the requirement of student's visa. Students are also obliged to **participate in all activities** arranged for the program except for special cases, ie. due to medical reasons.
2. **NO INDEPENDENT TRAVEL** is permitted at any case, nor is traveling alone at night. Students are obliged to **follow the guidelines** of Bina Antarbudaya staff/chapter in light of safety & security matters.
3. Students **are not allowed to consume alcohol and smoking** during their stay in Indonesia. Alcohol and smoking are not allowed at school and if students are caught smoking and drinking alcohol at school, they can get expelled because it is violating the rules.
4. **Natural parents, relatives and friends from the home country will not visit during the program** unless they have obtained prior consent from Bina Antarbudaya national office. Such visit, if permitted, should not be conducted during the 1st three (3) months and the last two (2) months of the program.
5. **The departure and return dates are determined by Bina Antarbudaya.** AFS students are required to abide to that schedule. **Students are not permitted to extend their stay** in Indonesia after the program ends, even if the natural parents agreed to release Bina Antarbudaya from any responsibility and liability.
6. Students **are subject to the rules and law of the Republic Indonesia.** Neither Bina Antarbudaya nor the sending country has the ability to protect student who becomes involved in drugs or other illegal activities.

We, the undersigned, stated that we have read, understood and accepted the specific rules and regulations of Bina Antarbudaya. We understand that violation of the rules and regulations will be sanctioned and may result in dismissal from the program, and that each case will be viewed individually by Bina Antarbudaya.
