

Pico Duarte November 2018

Between the Central Mountain Range, the protected areas are the National Park Armando Bermúdez and José del Carmen Ramírez, these places are the cradle of the highest mountain of all Caribbean, the majestic and enigmatic Pico Duarte. Most people describe the excursion to the Pico Duarte as the maximum adventure in the Dominican Republic.

It is a five-day adventure where we will make several stops for rest and supply.

During our trip we will see the Tetero Valley, the Yaque del Norte river, the Piedra Taína Petroglyph, the Whale watering place and other impressive places.

Duration: 5 Days

Approximate cost: 200USD - 250USD

What to bring with you:

- Sleeping bag
- Flashlight or head lamp
- Gloves
- Lipstick

- Plate, glass, fork, knife and spoon

Cayo Arena is a coral bank in the middle of the sea whose real name is Cayo Paraíso, located in the Northwest of the Dominican Republic of the coast of Puerto Plata in Punta Rucia. According to CNN travel, it is among the 35 most beautiful beaches in the world.

This natural phenomenon bank that is frequently visited by hundreds of tourists, is a jewel of nature, a true paradise of the Caribbean. The size of the coral bank shrinks and expands depending on the seasons of the ocean currents.

We will make a tour through the mangrove forest, a habitat that hosts countless animals such as the Antillean manatee and we will also visit La Ensenada beach.

South Coast trip June 2019

Later on we will go to Barahona and visit one of the shortest rivers in the world, the Patos's River. We will visit the paradisiac beach of Cabo Rojo, Bahía de las Águilas. On our last day we will go to the community of San Rafael to the San Rafael waterfall and then to San Rafael or Quemadito beach.
